Only those entries selected as eligible for National Awards must follow the additional ACEC National submittal requirements. Please note, only projects located within Washington State are eligible for Best in State awards.*

### SUBMISSION CHECKLIST FOR ENTRIES

#### All Projects

- Official Entry Form
- Do the dates fall within the range of November 1, 2019 and October 31, 2022?
- Do I have the signature of the Firm's Principal?
- Do I have the signature of the Client/Owner?
- Have I uploaded a one-page letter from the Owner/Client?
- Is the Executive Summary limited to **one page and singled spaced?**
- Is the Project Description limited to **six pages?**
- Have I uploaded a digital version of the 20x20" panel?
- Have I uploaded the six photographs?
- Are they labeled with proper captions?
- Are all of the documents, photos, and panel uploaded to the submission portal?

#### National Projects

- Did I upload three photos of the completed project?
- Did I upload three photos of the planning, start-up, and/or construction phase of the project?
- Please be sure the contact on the Official Entry Form will be available on January 26, 2023.
- If this is a Category A submission, have I included supplemental report documentation?
